On 29-31 August 2023, Associate Professor Dr. Witawat Jangiam (Dean of the Graduate School) and Assistant Professor Dr. Supphasin Thaweesak (Vice-Dean for Strategic Planning, Research, and International Affairs) were invited to attend the APCORE-PIKSI Hybrid International Conference 2023, held in Bandung, Indonesia. The event was attended by approximately 1,000 university administrators, researchers, government, and NGOs in Southeast Asia, both on-site and online. On this occasion, the Graduate School held preliminary discussions with administrators of many universities, including Dr. Theresita V. Atienza, President of Quezon City University, and Dr. Baby Boy Benjamin D. Nebres III, President of Bicol University, regarding cooperation in graduate programs. The Graduate School also promoted graduate programs by disseminating information to universities like the College of International Tourism and Hospitality Management and Lyceum of the Philippines. In order to organize such events in Thailand, the graduate school is now in discussions with deans who oversee graduate programs at institutions in Southeast Asia.

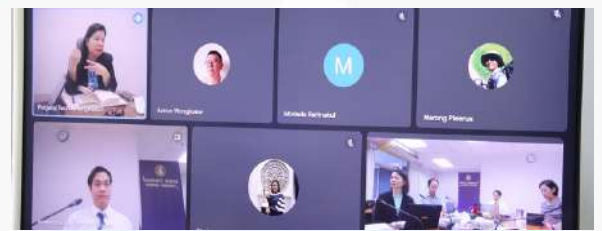

The Graduate School negotiate and discuss management of graduate education with the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences



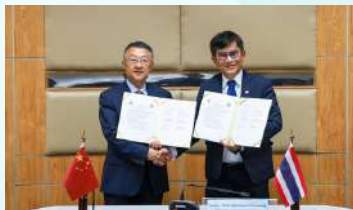
