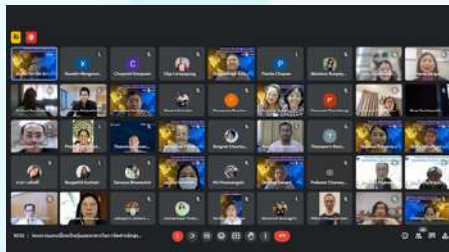

## Dean of Graduate School invited to summarize issues concerning research development related to medical plants and biodiversity for good human beings in the context of universities, government organizations, and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) at the 8<sup>th</sup> Global Summit on Medicinal and Aromatic Plants



On November 8, 2023, Associate Professor Dr. Witawat Jangiam, Dean of the Graduate School of Burapha University, was invited to summarize issues concerning research development related to medical plants and biodiversity in the context of universities, government organizations, and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) during the opening ceremony of the 8<sup>th</sup> Global Summit on Medicinal and Aromatic Plants at Mercure Bangkok Atrium, Thailand. He discussed the growing trend of in-depth study on the use of medicinal plants for the long-term improvement of human quality of life. He also provided instances of studies on several therapeutic plants that might be modified for use in modern medicine. Furthermore, biodiversity conservation may lead to the protection of endangered plants and animals, as well as the continued development of therapeutic plants that are useful to human health. Attendees from Burapha University included Asst. Prof. Supphasin Thaweesak (Vice-Dean for Strategic Planning, Research, and International Affairs and Research) from the Graduate School and Professor Dr. Guntima Suwannapong (bee expert) from the Faculty of Science, as well as researchers and students from the research group of ten people, led by Dr. Sanchai Naree and Ms. Preeyaporn Phonguttha. There were about 150 researchers from universities, government agencies, and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) from Thailand, India, the Republic of Korea, Iran, South Africa, Sri Lanka, etc.

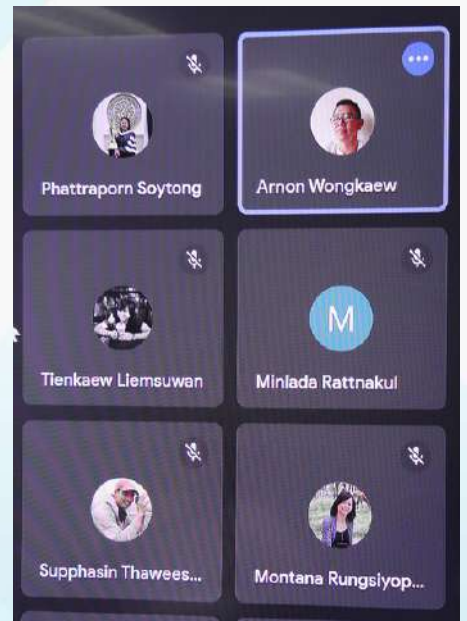
