The Graduate School participated in the 3/2025 Meeting of the Council of Graduate Studies Administrators of Thailand (CGAT)



Assoc. Prof. Dr. Witawat Jangiam, Dean of the Graduate School, Burapha University, attended the 3/2025 meeting of the Council of Graduate Studies Administrators of Thailand (CGAT), hosted by Udon Thani Rajabhat University on August 17-18, 2025.

The meeting featured a special lecture on "Trends of Change in Graduate Education Management (Present and Future)" delivered by Professor Dr. Kriengsak Chareonwongsak, University Council Member and President of the Nation-Building Institute. The lecture highlighted a key issue in the development of higher education in Thailand and provided a foundation for further discussion and exchange of ideas on the future of graduate education management.

In addition, the meeting included knowledge sharing on the requirements for doctoral graduation based on the Higher Education Standards Committee's Graduate Program Standards B.E. 2565 (2022). The session also concluded with the election of a new CGAT President. The meeting resolved to elect Assoc. Prof. Dr. Vichit U-On, Dean of the Graduate School of Management, Sripatum University, as the new CGAT President, who will officially assume the position on October 1, 2025.
