The event also served as a platform for sharing experiences, best practices, working processes, rules, and systematic recommendations related to the effective and efficient management of graduate students.



The Orientation Program for Incoming Graduate Students and the Graduate Diploma Program in Teaching Profession for the Second Semester of the 2025 Academic Year



On November 15, 2025, the Graduate School organized an online orientation for new graduate students for the second semester of the 2025 academic year via Zoom. The event was inaugurated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Watcharin Gasalak, President of Burapha University, followed by a welcoming address from Assoc. Prof. Dr. Witawat Jangiam, Dean of the Graduate School.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Supphasin Thaweesak, Vice-Dean for Strategic Planning, Research, and International Affairs, delivered a keynote session on "Curriculum Standards, Regulations, Announcements, Rules, and Guidelines Related to Graduate Students and the Graduate Diploma in Teaching Profession Program at Burapha University: Essential Information for New Students." In addition, representatives from the Computer Center and the Office of the Registrar provided briefings on academic information systems and related services.

At the second semester of the academic year 2025, Burapha University has a total of 175 new graduate students. There are 21 doctoral degrees (14 Thai students, 7 international students), 109 master's degree students (107 Thai students, 2 international students), and 45 students enrolled in the Graduate Diploma Program in Teaching Profession.

Graduate School Promotes Combined Bachelor's-Master's Programs and Graduate Programs at BUU Open House



On 20–21 November 2025, the Graduate School participated in promoting the Combined Bachelor's–Master's Programs and various graduate programs at the BUU Open House, held at Thamrong Buasri Auditorium, Burapha University.

The purpose of this outreach activity was to provide high school students and prospective learners with information about graduate-level programs and to raise awareness and understanding of the Combined Bachelor's–Master's Programs. The event also served as a venue for exchanging information, offering guidance, and providing direct consultation from the Graduate School.

Currently, Burapha University offers more than 100 graduate programs across 17 faculties/colleges, and 4 Combined Bachelor's–Master's Programs in four faculties: the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, the Faculty of Engineering, the Faculty of Political Science and Law, and the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. These programs offer high school students an alternative pathway to pursue continuous study, graduate faster, and gain greater opportunities for their future.
