Applicant Qualifications

1. Possess full qualifications according to the Burapha University Regulations on Graduate Studies, B.E. 2565 (2022).
2. Must hold a Master's Degree in Nursing accredited by the Nursing Council, or a Master's Degree in Health Sciences.
 - Note: Applicants holding a Master's degree in Health Sciences are required to complete additional coursework in Nursing Science and nursing specialties at the Master's level (both theoretical and clinical components). Applicants with clinical work or clinical teaching experience may be required to complete only the theoretical components.
3. A Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of not less than 3.50.
4. Hold a professional nursing license or a first-class nursing and midwifery license.
 - For International Applicants: Must hold a Master of Nursing Science (or equivalent) and possess a valid professional license issued by the relevant professional council or authorized regulatory body in their home country. In countries where no formal licensing system exists, applicants must provide official certificate or registration issued by the national Nursing Regulatory Authority.
5. English proficiency test scores must meet the criteria specified by Burapha University's announcements.

Selection Process: Selection is based on the consideration of application documents and an interview
