Announcement of the Graduate School, Burapha University

Subject: Research Grants for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026

Whereas the Graduate School, Burapha University, intends to provide research grants to support graduate students conducting dissertation and thesis research during Fiscal Year 2026; and Whereas the Graduate School Board, at its 2/2026 Meeting held on February 10, 2026, and the Research Grant Selection Committee for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, at its 1/2026 Meeting held on June 5, 2026, approved the allocation of such grants; therefore, by virtue of Burapha University Order No. 1686/2024 dated September 25, 2024, concerning the delegation of authority in budgetary and financial administration section 34, the Graduate School hereby announces the Research Grant Program for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, as follows:

1. Purpose

The Research Grant Program for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, provides financial support to graduate students who are currently undertaking doctoral dissertation or master's thesis research.

2. Objectives

2.1 To promote and support research operations for graduate students currently undertaking dissertations or theses.

2.2 To enhance research productivity and provide support for graduate students engaged in scholarly research.

3. Number of Grants

The total grant funding is 250,000 Baht, divided into 30 grants across the following categories:

3.1 Doctoral Dissertations: 10 grants, valued at 10,000 Baht each.

3.2 Master's thesis: 20 grants, valued at 7,500 Baht each.

Note: In the event that the number of applicants does not meet the specified quota for each category, the Research Grant Selection Committee for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, reserves the sole discretion to reallocate the proportion of the grants.

4. Applicant Qualifications

4.1 Must be a current graduate student of Burapha University who has not yet graduated and is not on an approved leave of absence on the date of application.

4.2 The dissertation or thesis proposal must have already been approved by the Dean of the Graduate School.

4.3 The dissertation or thesis proposal must have received Human Research Ethics approval, or must have been formally designated as exempt from ethical review in accordance with the Research Ethics Classification Form.

4.4 The applicant must not have received, or be in the process of applying for, any dissertation or thesis research grants from other departments/units either within or outside Burapha University.

5. Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be evaluated by the Research Grant Selection Committee for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, based on a total score of 100 points, allocated as follows:

Assessment Topic	Score
Promoting innovation development	40
Benefit received from dissertation, thesis, independent study	40
Accumulated Grade Point Average (GPAX)	10
Language used to write the full Dissertation/ Thesis	10
Total	100

6. Conditions for Grant Recipients

6.1 Recipients must complete their dissertation or thesis within the study timeframe stipulated by their graduate curriculum, not exceeding the period specified in the Burapha University Regulations on Graduate Studies, 2023.

If the student fails to graduate within the designated timeframe, they must return the full amount of the received grant within 1 month from the date their student status terminates.

If a recipient wishes to voluntarily withdraw from the grant program, they must return the full amount of the received grant within 1 month from the date of notifying their intention to terminate.

6.2 The completed, final version of the dissertation or thesis must include the following statement in the ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS section:

"This study was partially supported by research funding from the Graduate School, Burapha University, Thailand"

6.3 In the case where the research is published as a full paper in conference proceedings or published in an academic journal, the following statement must be included in the ACKNOWLEDGEMENT section:

"This study was partially supported by research funding from the Graduate School, Burapha University, Thailand"

7. Application Process

Applications may be submitted from the date of this announcement until July 31, 2026, via the online submission system at:

7.1 Application Form file (downloadable at <http://grd.buu.ac.th>).

7.2 The latest official transcript file showing the cumulative GPAX (except for Master's degree Plan 1/Plan A1 [thesis only] and Doctoral degree Plan 1.1).

7.3 Dissertation or Thesis Proposal Approval Form file signed by the Dean of the Graduate School (GRD-003).

7.4 Human Research Ethics Certificate file, or the Ethical Review Classification Report file specifying "Exempt from Ethical Review" approved by the Dean of the Graduate School.

Note: The Committee will only consider applicants who have fully completed the application form, obtained all required signatures from relevant parties, and attached all specified documents.

8. Announcement of Results

The Graduate School will announce the list of grant recipients on the Graduate School website (<http://grd.buu.ac.th>) no later than August 10, 2026.

9. Documents Required for Fund Disbursement

9.1 Two copies of the National ID card (or Passport for international students), with a certified true copy signature.

9.2 Two copies of the Student ID card, with a certified true copy signature.

9.3 One copy of the bank account book front page, with a certified true copy signature.

Grant recipients must personally sign and submit all certified documents mentioned in 9.1 – 9.3 to the Graduate School by August 20, 2026, at 4:00 PM. Failure to submit the required documents within the specified period will be deemed as forfeiting the grant.

The Dean of the Graduate School shall be responsible for the implementation of this Announcement. In the event of any issue arising from the interpretation or implementation of this Announcement, the Dean, in consultation with the Research Grant Selection Committee for Graduate Students, Fiscal Year 2026, shall have the authority to make decisions as deemed appropriate. Such decisions shall be final.
