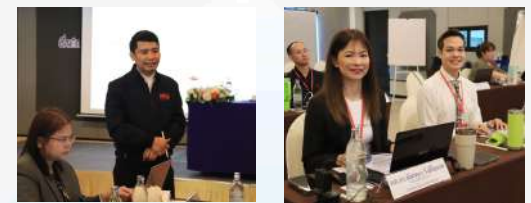

Graduate School of Burapha University Organizes EdPEX Workshop to Strengthen Organizational Excellence Development in Higher Education Institutions



The Graduate School, Burapha University, successfully organized an academic service project entitled “Advanced Workshop on Analyzing and Developing Organizational Excellence from Real Contexts of Higher Education Institutions” from 13-15 May 2026 at Bangsaen Heritage Hotel, Chonburi Province. The workshop attracted significant interest from executives and quality assurance personnel from both internal and external institutions, with participants representing more than 16 organizations and institutions.

The opening ceremony was presided over by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Witawat Jangiam, Dean of the Graduate School, Burapha University, who delivered the welcoming remarks and officially inaugurated the workshop. The event was also honored by the participation of Professor Dr. Kiaticchai Faksri, Dean of the Graduate School, Khon Kaen University, who served as the keynote speaker and facilitator, sharing his expertise and extensive experience in organizational excellence development based on the EdPEX framework throughout the intensive three-day program.

The workshop emphasized in-depth learning combined with practical hands-on activities, covering key topics such as organizational context analysis, organizational profile design, leadership and strategy, customer focus, measurement, analysis and knowledge management, as well as process design and continuous improvement toward excellent performance outcomes. These sessions were designed to enhance participants’ capabilities in applying the knowledge to improve the operational quality of their respective institutions in a concrete and systematic manner.

Throughout the program, participants actively engaged in knowledge exchange, collaborative discussions, and case-based analytical exercises. These activities enabled attendees to develop a systematic understanding of organizational excellence approaches and provided practical insights that could be further applied to the preparation of effective EdPEX reports that accurately reflect their institutions’ organizational capabilities and performance excellence.

Graduate School Holds the 4/2026 Meeting of the Graduate Integrated Curriculum Design Committee to Advance the Development of the Concept Proposal for a New University Program



The Graduate School, Burapha University, held the 4/2026 Meeting of the Graduate Integrated Curriculum Design Committee on 18 May 2026 at Meeting Room 702, Graduate School Office. The purpose of the meeting was to determine the direction and establish a framework for systematically designing the overall process of developing Burapha University’s integrated graduate program curriculum.

The meeting focused on reviewing the conclusions from the Focus Group discussions with key stakeholders, including educational institutions, relevant government agencies, startup entrepreneurs, industrial enterprises, and hospitals. The findings will serve as essential input for preparing the concept proposal for Burapha University’s new program: the Master of Science Program in Integrated Healthcare Management and Business Innovation (New Curriculum, B.E. 2027).

This meeting followed earlier consultative discussions in which the Graduate School collaborated with four faculties—the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, the International College, the Faculty of Public Health, and the Faculty of Logistics—to exchange ideas and develop the concept of a bilingual integrated master’s degree program in the Master of Science (MSc) group. The program is designed to integrate knowledge across multiple disciplines and to enhance both in-depth expertise and interdisciplinary competencies of learners, in alignment with contemporary economic, social, and technological contexts.
